## Three Elastic Experiences



At the beginning, singers should be spaced apart (left, center, right if possible) and walk in quietly from behind the audience. They should be in place along with the instrumental performers by measure 13. At the conclusion they leave in reverse order, continuing to sing.

The sounds are from Hawthorne, Mote and Leaf. Hawthorne is the aspirated "Hhaa" present at every entrance after a rest, and in closing the note's sound. Mote is the long "O" for all the pitches. Leaf is the "F", pitched only by the shape of the mouth, and the "L", not quite a hum as the air excapes through the side of the tongue.

The click sounds beginning at measure 147 are preferably done on nine small tuned hand drums. Otherwise, if done in the mouth, they should be the opposite sound-non-resonant, tip-of-tongue "tsk" sounds (a ‘sucking' tsk).
