Dear Minister and Choir Director:

The *Conceptual Church Hymn* you have received is a revised version of the *Hymn* premiered by the Roxbury Union Congregational Church Choir and guests in the spring of 1989.

Sunday, May 19, 1991, is your scheduled date for the performance of this new version, and copies have been sent throughout Vermont for joint performance on this day. The performance itself, however, is conceptual. Whether or not your choir members actually sing this *Hymn* at your services, the unique copy of the score prepared for you will be performed, at least conceptually, by your choir on May 19. Such a performance will be imagined, but not imaginary. Hundreds of singers across Vermont will participate in the active silence of this music on that day.

The *Conceptual Church Hymn* score may be performed either as 100 beats or 100 measures. Each singer has a unique score; of the hundreds of parts sent throughout the state, no two are alike. (Ten unique parts are enclosed for you.) At each change (beat or measure, your choice), the singers perform one instruction on the score. After 99 instructions, the score concludes with a simultaneous fermata for everyone.

Thank you for your interest and participation in this *Conceptual Church Hymn*. It is dedicated to peace in the world.
